Parking & Transportation

BUS TRANSPORTATION

The City of Key West Department of Transportation (Key West Transit) notes these transportation changes during Fantasy Fest:

- Road closures will begin the weekend of the Bahama Village Goombay Festival, Oct.23 and Oct. 24 which will cause delays and detours to regular bus service, scheduled pick-up points and times.
- Buses will NOT provide service west of Simonton Street on Oct. 23, Oct. 24, Oct. 30 and Oct. 31, 2015 during the Bahama Village Goombay Festival and Fantasy Fest, due to street events and road closures on both weekends.
- Regular bus service in the downtown area will resume Sunday morning after 7 AM on Oct. 25 and Nov. 1, or as soon as streets are reopened to traffic.
- Events planned throughout Fantasy Fest during weekdays may prevent buses from servicing stops west of Simonton Street - updated information will be posted on the City's website at www.cityofkeywest-fl.gov and on the City's Real Time Passenger Information System at www.kwtransit.com. Real time bus information is also available by calling (305) 600-1455.
- On Saturday Oct. 31, regular bus service will operate until 4:59 PM, at which time ALL City and Lower Kevs bus service will convert to SAFE RIDE shuttles for the parade event.




The City of Key West Department of Transportation is pleased to announce SAFE RIDE shuttle bus service for the 2015 3Wishes.com Fantasy Fest Parade event.

- Lower Keys service between Key West and Marathon will be \$4.00 each way and Key West City service will be \$2.00 each way.
- Shuttles will operate on Saturday Oct. 31 between 5:00 PM AND 2:00 AM.
- The last Lower Keys shuttles will depart Key West no later than 12:30 AM (after midnight) for return trips to Marathon. Plan ahead, seating is limited on the last bus out!
- City bus shuttles will have a final pick up call at 1:45 AM.
- The designated drop off / pick up point for the shuttles is Fausto's on Fleming and Bahama Streets.
- All buses will travel clockwise, counter-clockwise and figure eight in Key West and Stock Island with Keys shuttles rotating between Key West and Marathon as traffic permits.
- Additional information will be available at www.kwtransit.com and www.cityofkeywest-fl.gov.
- Taxis will be located in special pick-up areas outside the designated Fantasy Zone (portions of Duval St. and the adjoining side streets).

PARKING

The City of Key West suggests festival attendees find parking at one of the following locations: City Parking Lots: Rates are for Friday, Oct. 30, beginning at 8:00 AM, through Sunday, Nov. 1, ending at noon.

- ullet Old Town Garage (Park N' Ride), at the corner of Grinnell and Caroline streets, \$30 per entry per day.
- Mallory Square, near the intersection of Duval and Front streets, \$4 per hour or \$32 per day.
- Key West Bight, at the corner of Caroline and Williams streets, \$2.00 per hour or \$16.25 per day.

Rates are based on a 24-hour maximum period. Parking at Key West High School serves as a fundraiser for the Senior Class and Girls' Softball Team.

Shuttle bus service from the Key West High School to Simonton Street (at Southard / Fausto's) will be available from 1 PM to 8 PM on Saturday only. Fee is \$2.00 per trip.

PARKING ETIQUETTE

If you are able to find in-town parking, please remember:

- Be courteous and do not block private driveways, entrances, etc.
- Watch carefully for "No Parking," including "Resident only," areas. As the festival progresses, there
 will be additional no parking areas blocked off.
- Parking restrictions are enforced. Towing may occur to keep traffic and festival activities moving smoothly. If your vehicle should be towed, please call the Police non-emergency number 305-809-1111. Parking tickets may also be paid at City Hall in the Revenue Department or mailed as indicated.
- Plan your exit route carefully to avoid being blocked by Parade activities or heavy congestion.
- Please watch for emergency vehicles attempting to access the very crowded side streets.
- Oversized vehicles such as RV's, Tour Buses, Motor Homes, and others are not permitted to travel
 in the old town/downtown areas of Key West. City Ordinance prohibits parking oversized vehicles
 on city streets. Oversized vehicles are required to drop and pick up passengers East of White Street
 in Key West.

Use caution at all times while traveling in the downtown area during the Street Fair, the Masquerade March and during the 3Wishes.com Fantasy Fest Parade. And, as always, be sure to have a stellar time!





ith an emphasis on family-friendly fun, this exuberant street party showcases island arts and crafts, music and food in the heart of Key West's historic

Bahama Village neighborhood. The festival's main entertainment stage is located at the corner of Petronia and Fort Streets on Truman Annex, and features nonstop musical entertainment ranging from gospel to reggae.

Sharing a musical connection to calypso, Goombay is named for the goatskin drums it is traditionally played on. In Key West, the Goombay Festival is known for gathering a high-energy range of musical entertainment that shows off the island's multicultural heritage. The festival entertainment offen includes a Junkanoo Rush, a costumed march of dancers and performers.

The food at Goombay shows off similarly diverse influences, from conch fritters, black



n Friday, Oct. 30 and Saturday, Oct. 31, portions of Duval Street and the adjoining side streets will be designated as the official Fantasy Zone. The city of Key West will temporarily suspend the normal open container law within the Fantasy Zone for these two days only. From noon to midnight revelers can stroll, march, prance or do the super shuffle while sipping libations along Duval Street from Front to South streets, as well as intersecting cross streets from Simonton to Whitehead St.

For your safety, cans and glass bottles are not allowed. Please use only the paper and plastic cups available at local bars and from vendors. Of course, thanks to our thoughtful city staff, all festival-goers may properly dispose of drink containers in the many recycle bins available at Fantasy Zone exits.

PORT-O-LETS SPELL RELIEF

Port-o-lets are just about everywhere you may need to go during the Street Fair, Duval Street Promenade and 3Wishes.com Fantasy Fest Parade. Fantasy Fest sponsor Waste Management is providing safe and clean relief stations bordering the Duval Street festival activities. When the urge strikes, be sure to look for directional arrows on Duval Street pointing toward the port-o-let locations on the cross streets. Remember, relief is always just around the corner!

he Key West Tourist Development Association and the Key West Police Department welcome you to Florida's premier masking and costuming celebration and encourage you to participate in all the many exciting events of the "All Hallows Intergalactic Freak Show." We want you to have an interstellar adventure, but following a few simple rules will make Fantasy Fest 2015 a safe and enjoyable time.

Below, the City of Key West Police Department summarizes the rules and laws by which you must abide:

- No glass containers are allowed in the designated "Fantasy Zone." Drink from paper or plastic cups provided by bars and vendors.
- Open containers of alcohol are not allowed outside the Fantasy Zone. Please stay inside

the party area while you are carrying open alcoholic beverages. For your convenience, trashcans and recycle bins are located along the boundary of the Fantasy Zone. Toss your cups in the recycle bins as you leave the area as Waste Management now recycles plastics 1 through 7.

- The Fantasy Zone is marked with bright pink caution tape. As you leave the Fantasy Zone, please remember that all normal laws apply.
- Nudity is ILLEGAL and is NOT allowed on public property or in public view at any time inside or outside of the Fantasy Zone.
- Lewd acts on public property or in public view are strictly ILLEGAL and NOT tolerated.
- Body painting is allowed but must be performed in enclosed or screened in areas, entirely out of public view. Painted female

breasts are permitted ONLY WITHIN the designated Fantasy Zone. Outside of the Fantasy Zone, please wear a cover-up to avoid ILLEGAL exposure on public property and on all city streets.


by a fantastic crowd of revelers. The All Hallows Intergalactic Freak Show will inspire an out-of-thisworld parade and a 10-day party like none you've ever seen. Fantasy Fest organizers are encouraging partygoers to have a great time and stay safe.

PARADE VIEWING

The 3Wishes.com Fantasy Fest Parade launches its extraterrestrial madness from the Gulf of Mexico to the Atlantic Ocean on Saturday, Oct. 31, 2015. The parade steps off at 7 PM and takes at least two hours to complete.

It is expected to reach its most challenging, 120-degree turn at Front and Duval Streets at roughly 7:45 PM and should be in the upper blocks of Duval Street around 8:30 PM.

If you're hoping to see the extravaganza and get home at a reasonable hour, try to catch the madness as it passes through the intersection of Southard and Whitehead Streets. Upper Duval, beyond Virginia Street, is often less congested and tends to be a little friendlier for those who are somewhat claustrophobic. Please remember, the downtown area is very congested and parking is limited because most streets remain closed until the parade is completed.



WHEELCHAIR ACCESS

A special area for wheelchair-accessible viewing of the 2015 3Wishes.com Fantasy Fest Parade will be available on Duval Street at Virginia Street. Handicapped-accessible parking and port-o-lets will be available near the Gato Building at the corner of Virginia and Simonton Streets.

BARRICADES

Barricades will be placed in congested areas along the parade route to keep spectators safe and to allow the parade entrants room to perform. These simple yet vital pieces of equipment can keep revelers from ending up under the wheels of a magnificent float. They're put up with safety in mind, so please be a good sport when city employees begin setting them in place before the parade.

The parade needs extra leeway from the crowd at intersections where the procession makes turns. Please cooperate with parade ambassadors and law enforcement personnel to provide a safe turning radius for the parade vehicles.

Please be cautious around the barricades and step out of the way when city workers disassemble

them after the parade. It's a challenging job, so give them an encouraging word when you see them.

PARADE AMBASSADORS

More than 100 Parade Ambassadors will be stationed along the parade route to help keep the spectators out of harm's way and from under the wheels of the rolling festivities.

These very special people stay sober on party night to be the responsible shepherds of the 3Wishes.com Fantasy Fest Parade.

You will recognize these noble, funloving people by their distinctive T-shirts. They each have undergone extensive training sessions for this very important job and they are in radio contact with the parade director and law enforcement personnel. Please let them know we appreciate them. Smile, thank them, and cooperate with their directions.

IT'S POLITE TO ASK FIRST

Please ask permission before snapping photos of other partygoers and practice positive festival etiquette by treating other people's costumes (no matter how skimpy) as works of art. Look and admire, but don't touch!

STREET CLOSURES

To accommodate the many street activities during Fantasy Fest, portions of several streets will be closed during the festivities and the parade.

- On Friday, Oct. 30, Duval Street from Front Street to Truman Avenue is closed to traffic beginning at 10 AM. Side street crossings are at Front Street, Eaton Street, Fleming Street, Southard Street, Angela Street, Olivia Street, and Truman Avenue.
- On Saturday, Oct. 31, beginning at 10 AM, the following streets will be closed: Duval Street is closed from Front Street to Truman Avenue.

Front Street, Eaton Street, and Truman Avenue are the only accessible cross streets.

- On Saturday, Oct. 31 from 4 PM until the parade ends, Whitehead Street is closed from Truman Avenue to Front Street. All Duval crossings are closed from Front Street to United Street. Southard Street from Truman Waterfront to Simonton Street will also be closed.
- Several parking lots will also be closed from 8
 AM on Friday, Oct. 30 until noon on Sunday,
 Nov. 1: the parking lot in the 500 block of Thomas Street, the parking lot in the 300 block of Fleming Street, as well as the 500 block of Angela Street.
