Arts & Craft vendors may begin submitting applications as of June 7, 2018. **We are arranging booths to create the best possible mix of vendors, so this year vendors can indicate a block preference, but we will not guarantee any specific location.** Arts & Craft booths are located in the **400, 500, 600, 700 and 800 blocks.** (For reference, see map, page 4.) All blocks may have some food and/or sponsor booths. We cannot guarantee proximity to or exclusion from specific other vendors or kinds of vendors, but please do let us know if you would prefer to be located away from food booths. We will only fill the 800 block if we have suitable demand.

Important information – please read

- Fantasy Fest is now being produced by We've Got the Keys. The best way to reach the Street Fair coordinators is via email: streetfair@fantasyfest.com. We are in and out of the office, but you may also call the Fantasy Fest office at 305-295-9112.
- Please make sure you have signed the application agreement/release (page 3). Your signed application constitutes a written agreement to abide by all Street Fair rules. The full list of rules will be included in your vendor packet. Your deposit will be forfeited if the rules are not followed.
- **Applications must be filled out in their entirety.** Payment by check will only be accepted prior to September 15, 2018. Please make checks payable to Fantasy Fest 2018. Applications without payment will be returned.
- Receipt of application and payment **does NOT guarantee** vendor space. If booths are sold out, your application and payment will be returned to you.
- Fantasy Fest is held rain or shine, and booth payment are non-refundable after August 1st, unless we are able to resell the reserved booth space. No attendance or sales guarantees are implied or offered.
- **The Street Fair is intended to showcase artisan crafts and goods. If your products are not handmade by you, please call us and see if we can accommodate you. Please note the list of excluded products on page 5**

Entrant Release Agreement – Fantasy Fest Street Fair 2018

The undersigned, being fully aware of the risks and hazards inherent in participating in the Event, hereby elects voluntarily to engage in such activities. The undersigned hereby voluntarily assumes all risk of loss, damage or injury, including death that may be sustained by the undersigned and/or employees and/or volunteers in the Event.

This release shall be binding upon all distributees, heirs, next of kin, personal representatives, executors and administrators of the undersigned.

The undersigned also acknowledges the fact that the Sponsors may publish photographs of the Event to be used in connection with the promotion and advertising of Sponsor brands for future events. The undersigned hereby grants to the Sponsor the right to use his/her likeness in photographs or on film or video in the above promotional and advertising materials and may be exhibited without limitation or liability.

This release agreement shall extend to claims, demands and cause of action whatsoever arising wholly or in part from any act or omission of the Sponsor, their officers, directors, agents and employees or any one or more of them.

- Booths are non-transferable and must be operated by the individuals/company that purchased them. We reserve the right to reject or accept vendors at our sole discretion.
- Use of the Fantasy Fest® logo and theme “Oh..The Games We Play”™ is not allowed without written permission.
- Arts and Crafts must be hand-made by the vendor, and not manufactured. If you wish to sell manufactured items, please contact us for additional fees and restrictions. **NEW FOR 2018- we will offer a limited number of “boutique clothing” vendors. If you question your items, please send photo samples and brief description to streetfair@fantasyfest.com. No T-shirts, buttons, glow sticks, sunglasses, or ball caps. Beads are allowed only if hand-made.**
- You are prohibited from engaging in activities that promote or encourage nudity, including body painting or body jewelry. No vulgar, pornographic or objectionable items are allowed to be sold during the Street Fair.
- All instructions from the Police, City Officials and Fantasy Fest staff must be complied with.
- Please come prepared with everything you need to set up, operate, break down and clean up after your booth, including tables, chairs, shade, water, lighting, garbage cans and can liners. We do not provide equipment or power.
