

Transportation and Parking Information –

Fantasy Fest 2019

The City of Key West Department of Transportation invites party goers to Park and Ride with Us - for a safe and responsible Fantasy Fest 2019

Public Transportation:

- Road closures will begin the weekend of Goombay Festival, 10/18 and 10/19 which will cause delays and detours to regular bus services, scheduled pick-up points and times.
- Buses will not provide service west of Simonton Street on Friday, 10/18, 10/25 and Saturday 10/19, 10/26 (Parade events on both weekends.)
- Regular bus service will resume Sunday morning, both weeks, or 10/20 and 10/27/2019. Note that events planned throughout the week may prevent buses from servicing stops west of Simonton Street - updated information will be posted on the City's website at www.cityofkeywest-fl.gov and on the City's Real Time Passenger Information System at www.kwtransit.com or call (305) 600-1455.
- On Saturday 10/26/19, regular bus service will operate until 4:59 pm, at which time all City and Lower Keys bus service will convert to "SAFE RIDE" shuttles for the parade event. Please note that there will be a short service interruption while buses change shifts; please plan accordingly. The Duval Loop will end at 12:00 Noon on 10/26.

"SAFE RIDE" Shuttles:

- Shuttles will operate on Saturday 10/26/2019 between 5:00 pm and 2:00 am. Shuttles end at 2:00 am with the last trip from Key West to Marathon departing Fausto's at 12:30 am.
- Lower Keys shuttles will depart Key West no later than 12:30 am (after midnight) for return trips to Marathon. Plan ahead, seating is limited on the last bus out! Fare is \$ 4.00 / person / trip each way. (Exact change required – drivers do not make change.)
- City bus shuttles will have a final pick up call at 1:45 am. Fare is \$ 2.00 / person / trip each way. (Exact change each way drivers do not make change.)
- The designated drop off / pick up point for the shuttles is Fausto's on Fleming and Bahama Streets.
- All buses will travel clockwise & counter-clockwise in Key West & Stock Island with Keys shuttles rotating between Key West and Marathon as traffic permits. - Official Fantasy Zone Code of Conduct will be enforced. Nudity is illegal AND NOT allowed on public property or in public view. Body paint does not constitute clothing – bring a cover up! Shoes Required on bus.

Municipal Parking:

The City operates three (3) municipal parking lots at the following locations and the following rates

1) Park N' Ride (Old Town Garage)
2) Mallory Square
3) Key West Bight
4) Truman Waterfront

\$4.00 / hr or \$32 / day \$5.00 / hr or \$40 / day \$4.00 / hr or \$32 / day \$4.00 / hr

Oversized Vehicles such as RV's, Tour Buses, Motor Homes, and others are not permitted to travel in the old town / downtown areas of Key West. City Ordinance prohibits parking oversized vehicles on city streets. Oversized vehicles are required to drop and pick up passengers at William & Caroline or the 1110 Block of Simonton St. in the City.
